Dear President Metsola,
I write regarding Amazon's engagement with the European Parliament and to emphasize our position as a responsible employer creating quality jobs in the European Union.

You will be aware that the Employment and Social Affairs Committee has not accepted our proposed representatives, despite their seniority and expertise, at its 26th June hearing on 'Working Conditions at Amazon'. The hearing will therefore take place without the participation of Amazon senior leadership to exchange with the committee. Our nominated representatives are:

- Mr. Stefano Perego, Vice-President of International Operations and Global Operations Services, who leads our European operations and is responsible for our global fulfilment network outside of the United States. He also serves on the Amazon EU Sarl board;
- Myself, bringing extensive government engagement and policy expertise to the discussion.

In addition to our nominated representatives remaining available for this week's hearing, our Senior Vice-President for Global Affairs & Legal, Mr. David Zapolsky, would be pleased to meet with you to discuss broader policy issues of interest to you and to the Parliament in Washington DC. This would facilitate meaningful dialogue within a short timeframe.

We remain committed to constructive engagement with the Employment and Social Affairs Committee, ideally on June 26th, and look forward to coordinating a meeting between you and Mr. Zapolsky in Washington in the coming weeks.
